Annual General Meeting

The General Membership meeting was held on Saturday December 2nd. There were a number of topics discussed. A financial report was distributed and discussed. Some of the 2017 accomplishments were shared including: The fence was repaired in park by Carroll Weichers. Water leak repaired on outgoing side of front entrance. Aerators were maintenanced and one aerator had to be replaced. Front entrance sign repainted (still being worked on). Mailbox purchased for suggestions and ballots, it was placed in the park. Two traffic turtles (SLOW) purchased. Replaced playground timbers in park with pvc pipe. Added 55 bags of mulch to playground area.

The Board also laid out some planned projects for 2018: Resolve the erosion problem at the end of Oakmont, purchase 2 benches for the park, make additional improvements to the park, have a work day in the spring, and have a social function in the fall.

Hurricane Protection Project

According to recent newspaper articles the Westshore Lake Pontchartrain Risk Hurricane Project, with it, greater flood and hurricane protection for St. John the Baptist residents, is not currently in the Federal Budget. While this Project was approved in 2016 by then President Obama, has been removed from the Corp of Engineers budget by President Trump. Parish President Robottom and U.S. Senator Garret Graves said that residents of St. John the Baptist Parish can assist by calling the State and Federal delegation for support for reinstatement of these funds. ARCHITECTURAL REVIEW REQUIREMENTS-

Please submit all plans for new construction or improvements to the Architectural Control Committee in care of:

For your convenience you can also submit this to any board member and we will see that it gets to Mr. Brazil

Also, please note that you have an obligation to St. John the Baptist Parish to obtain a building permit for any new construction or improvements to your existing property. For more information concerning the parish ordinances you can call (985) 652-9569.

New construction plans should include:

- House elevations showing front, rear & both sides of the structure. The elevations should show exterior wall materials, roof pitch from all angles & slab elevation in relation to street.
- Floor plans with living area & under roof area calculated on plans.
- Site plan showing lot dimensions, location & width of driveways & sidewalks, setback distances from the lot lines for the house, garage, patio, drive, sidewalk & any other ground improvements.
- Name, address, lot number & phone number of homeowner & the builder (if different).
- There is a \$200.00 architectural committee fee for new homes.

Existing homes must submit prior to construction:

- Location of improvements drawn on a site plan showing lot line setbacks.
- Materials to be used.
- Fences materials, height & type.
- Bulkheads materials, height & type
- Additions plans showing elevations, roof pitch & exterior wall materials.
- Above-Ground Improvements exceeding 3' height precise dimensions & location on lot.
- Swimming Pools type of pool & fencing.
- Name, address, lot number & phone number of homeowner.
- Any fee incurred will be passed on to the homeowner.
